

Geometrical design details seem to shine in most settings. It can elevate the contemporary style with a characterful take or add an intricate three-dimensional feel to a vintage setting. While most people stick to geometric-shaped tiles of a single colour, did you know you can try out distinctive tile arrangements of more than one tone? Here are some variations that can evoke a stronger visual impact:

## 1 Two-Tone

This two-tone tile treatment draws out a bold monochromatic style of stripes. While the tiles itself are of geometrical shapes, it is interesting how the final results derive a striped pattern.



## 2 Triple Tone

A triple combo of tiles which comprises metallic finishes can afford a bland-looking space with tons of visual interest. Do work in a neutral-coloured tone such as a white tile to allow the stronger tones to pop.





## 3 Multi-Tone

Up for something bold? Mix things up with tiles of different patterns to really take the style ante further. Regulate this whimsical collage of tiles to a corner or a feature wall. Less is definitely more with these heavy textures so limit the number of tiles used to prevent a visual overload.
